AMENDED ORDER SETTING POST-HEARING BRIEFING

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, the Court ordered all parties to file reply post-hearing briefs 21 days after the submission of the post-hearing briefs.

WHEREAS, the parties received the final transcript from the Court Reporter on March 2, 2020, setting the deadline for post-hearing briefs and proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order for April 1, 2020, and reply post-hearing briefs for April 22, 2020.

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, Relators made an unopposed motion to extend the briefing schedule three weeks based on the impact on normal work schedules due to closures and restrictions designed to curtail the spread of COVID-19.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. Relators' unopposed motion to extend the briefing schedule three weeks is **GRANTED**.
- 2. All parties shall file their post-hearing briefs and proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order on **April 22**, **2020**.
 - 3. All parties shall file their reply post-hearing briefs on May 13, 2020.
