ORDER REGARDING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT AND PROPOSED COMMENTS TO THOSE RULES

In an order filed on May 13, 2022, we granted in part and denied in part the petitions of the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board and the Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility (collectively, LPRB) and the Minnesota State Bar Association (MSBA) to amend Minn. R. Prof. Conduct 7.2 through 7.5. We stated the effective date of the amendments to these rules would be July 1, 2022. Because we adopted only some of the proposed amendments and made other amendments that were not reflected in either petition, we did not incorporate comments to the rules in our May 13 order. Instead, we invited the LPRB and the MSBA to jointly file proposed amendments to the comments by June 17, 2022.

Presently before us is a motion of the LPRB and the MSBA for an additional 60 days in which to submit their proposed amendments to the comments. The MSBA further requests that we extend the effective date of the amendments to these rules by 60 days. The LPRB asks us to maintain the July 1, 2022, effective date.
