PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER

ORDER

Based on the submissions of the parties and all of the files and records of this proceeding, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Scheduling Order regarding the claim for the proposed discharge of Bremer Trust, National Association ("Bremer") as the Special Administrator of the Estate of Prince Rogers Nelson ("Estate") and the approval of the final accounting of Bremer is as follows:

- 1. The heirs of Prince Rogers Nelson who desire to petition the Court to allow them to proceed as limited special administrators for the purpose of bringing a claim on behalf of the Estate against Bremer shall file their petition to be appointed as limited special administrators and proposed complaint by June 26, 2017.
- 2. All fact discovery must be noticed and completed on or before August 18, 2017;
 - a. The parties shall be limited to eight fact depositions. Additional depositions must be approved by the Court;
 - b. The parties shall serve no more than 20 Requests for Production of Documents, 20 Interrogatories, and 20 Requests for Admission upon any party by no later than July 7, 2017.
- 3. The limited special administrator(s) shall disclose the name of any witness who shall present evidence under Minnesota Rules of Evidence 702, 703, or 705 and shall submit a report that complies with Minnesota Rule of Civil Procedure 26.01(b)(2) by August 25, 2017.

- 4. Bremer shall disclose the identity and substantive opinions of any rebuttal witnesses by September 29, 2017.
- 5. All dispositive and non-dispositive motions must be noticed and heard on or before November 10, 2017;
 - a. Opening briefs shall be filed by October 13, 2017;
 - b. Responsive briefs shall be filed October 27, 2017.
- 6. An evidentiary hearing, if necessary, will be held no later than December 15, 2017.
