ORDER UNSEALING MEMORANDUM & HEIRSHIP AFFIDAVITS SUBMITTED IN SUPPORT OF VENITA JACKSON LEVERETTE'S OBJECTION TO PROTOCOL PRIOR TO GENETIC TESTING

In the "Order Unsealing Certain Records" filed on June 29, 2016, the Court addressed various submissions which had been filed under seal and not entered into MNCIS; and ordered that all documents filed by claimants who are claiming that they are a parent, a sibling, a half-sibling or other relative of Prince Rogers Nelson will be deemed public and will be filed in MNCIS as public documents except for attachments, or information contained within a document, such as social security numbers, bank account records, genetic testing records, death certificates, or, in some cases birth records, which will continued to be considered confidential. The Court stayed that order until July 11, 2016 to allow parties to either comment on the Court's Order or withdraw their Affidavits or submissions.

On June 24, 2016, the Court received and ordered sealed the "Memorandum of Law in Support of Venita Jackson Leverette's Objection to Protocol Prior to Genetic Testing;" and the "Affidavit of James Selmer in Support of Venita Jackson Leverette's Objection to Protocol Prior to Genetic Testing." No request for withdrawal of these submissions was received by the Court.

Pursuant to the "Order Unsealing Certain Records" filed on June 29, 2016, the Court hereby makes the following:

## ORDER

1. The "Memorandum of Law in Support of Venita Jackson Leverette's Objection to Protocol Prior to Genetic Testing," and the "Affidavit of James Selmer in Support of Venita Jackson Leverette's Objection to Protocol Prior to Genetic Testing" shall be filed in MNCIS as public documents. Any included confidential information such as social security numbers, bank account records, genetic testing records, or death certificates, shall be filed separately with an appropriate Confidential Information form.
