Event and Ticket Information

About the event:

The Minnesota Supreme Court and the Fifth Judicial District invite you to meet and share a meal and conversation with Supreme Court justices and area judges on Tuesday, October 8. The dinner will be hosted in the grand ballroom at the Holiday Inn in Fairmont, Minnesota.

The doors will open at 5:30 p.m. and dinner will be served at 6 p.m. The event will include a short program featuring remarks from members of the Supreme Court.

Ticket information:

The Court is grateful for the assistance of the Fairmont Community Education & Recreation (CER) Office, which is managing the sale of tickets for the event.

Tickets to the community dinner must be purchased in advance and **will not** be available at the door. There are a limited number of tickets available. The deadline to purchase tickets is **Tuesday, October 1**. Tickets for the community-wide event are being sold for \$20.00 to cover the cost of dinner, which includes caesar salad, fresh baked bread, pork loin with plum barbeque sauce, parsley buttered baby red potatoes, green beans, and cheesecake.

- **In person** by visiting the Fairmont CER office (714 Victoria Street, Fairmont). Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

When purchasing tickets, you will be asked for the first and last names of each attendee. When you arrive for dinner on October 8, please check in at the welcome table at the grand ballroom to receive your nametag, which will serve as your ticket to the event.

Seating is limited and tickets must be purchased by Tuesday, October 1.
