# McLeod/Sibley ENE Provider Roster Criteria

## PROVIDER CRITERIA

#### Requirements of all candidates

- 1. ENE Training
- 2. Observations:
  - a. SENE: 3 observations with 3 different evaluators. If the candidate has been a participant in an SENE, it counts as an observation. However, at least one observation must be as non-participant observer. The best practices for a SENE would be two individuals, a man and a woman team, but no requirement for the team to be an attorney/non-attorney.
    - b. FENE: 1 observation as a non-participant observer.
- 3. Availability and willingness to schedule session dates in the near future, (usually within two weeks of the contact date).
- 4. Agrees to abide by the county fee schedule for payment of services.

### Additional requirements for attorneys:

- 1. In good standing.
- 2. A minimum of 5 years family law experience.
- 3. Family law trial or contested hearing experience.

#### **Additional requirements for non-attorneys:**

- 1. Master degree/Professional license (CPA for Financial early neutral evaluations)
- 2. In good standing in professional licensure area.
- 3. A minimum of 5 years of experience working with families and children/dissolution.
