Simultaneously with the filing of the Motion, Comerica filed publicly redacted versions of the Comerica Letter Response and Exhibits A, B, and C to the Comerica Letter Response. Because the filings contain confidential information, the public filing of the unredacted information could impede the effective administration of the Estate.

Therefore, the Court makes the following:

ORDER

1. Based upon the confidential nature of the redacted contents of the Comerica Letter Response and Exhibits A, B, and C to the Comerica Letter Response, they may be filed and kept under seal until further order of this Court. The redacted information qualifies as confidential commercial information under Minn. R. Civ. P. 26.03(g), and there is no historical right of access to the information under the test articulated in *Minneapolis Star & Tribune Co. v. Schumacher*, 392 N.W.2d 197 (Minn. 1986).
