Dear Judge Eide:

I write in response to the Court's Second Order for Submissions Regarding the Motion to Expand Authority of the Second Special Administrator. On November 17, 2017, SNJ filed their memorandum in opposition to the motion. At this time SNJ maintain their opposition to the expansion of the SSA's authority for the reasons articulated in the November 17 memorandum, but do not intend to file a supplemental memorandum.

However, SNJ do not agree with certain parts of the investigation and conclusions in the SSA's report, including but not limited to the SSA's primary focus on only Stinson's and Meister Seelig's legal work. There were a number of other attorneys who worked on the UMG Agreement, and who may have potential liability, but they were not investigated or discussed in the SSA's report. SNJ are concerned that the SSA's investigation was incomplete and question whether there is sufficient value in expanding the authority of the SSA at this time. Thus, SNJ maintain their objection to expanding the authority of the SSA to investigate whether any action should be pursued for return of the advance paid by Jobu Presents to the Estate related to the Prince Tribute Concert.
