The two-step analysis in *Minneapolis Star & Tribute Co. v. Schumacher*, 392 N.W.2d 197 (Minn. 1986) supports keeping the appointment and activity of the second special administrator confidential. First, there is no historic right of access to similar proceedings. As such, the Court would not proceed to the second step in the analysis. But even if it did, the public has no constitutional right of access. *See id.* at 204.

Keeping the second special administrator proceedings under seal will allow forthright discussion of recent confidential business negotiations, and protect the Estate's ability to make future entertainment deals. Maintaining the confidentiality of these discussions is in keeping with this Court's September 14, 2016 order, commenting that it is important to "maintain[] the confidentiality of business negotiations which, if made public, may impede administration of the

estate, compromise the Special Administrator's ability to negotiate contract terms, or devalue estate assets."
