[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING STIPULATION TO AMEND SCHEDULING ORDER RELATING TO CLAIMS ASSERTED BY ROC NATION AND AFFILIATED ENTITIES

The above-captioned matter came before the undersigned on a Stipulation to Amend Scheduling Order Relating to Claims Asserted by Roc Nation and Affiliated Entities entered into between Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A., as Personal Representative of the Estate of Prince Rogers Nelson (the Personal Representative"), and Roc Nation LLC, Aspiro AB, Project Panther, Ltd. and WiMP Music AS (collectively, "<u>Petitioners</u>"). ORDER

1. Petitioners will serve responses and objections to the Personal Representative's

Requests for Admission on or before December 1, 2017.

2. All factual discovery shall be completed by <u>March 15, 2018</u>.

3. The parties shall make expert disclosures as follows:

a. The identity of any expert who may testify at trial regarding issues on which the party has the burden of persuasion must be disclosed on or before <u>March 15</u>, <u>2018</u>.

b. The initial expert written report completed in accordance with Minn. R. Civ. P. 26.01(b)(4)(A) must be served on or before <u>April 15, 2018</u>.

c. Written reports of rebuttal experts completed in accordance with Minn. R. Civ. P. 26.01(b)(4)(B) must be served on or before <u>May 15, 2018</u>.

4. All dispositive and non-dispositive motions shall be filed by <u>August 1, 2018</u>.

5. Except as modified herein, all other provisions of the Court's Scheduling Order

Relating to Claims Asserted by Roc Nation and Affiliated Entities filed May 1, 2017 and

amended on September 12, 2017 and October 12, 2017 shall remain in full force and effect.
