### **NOTICE OF MOTIONS AND MOTIONS**

The defendant is charged with second degree intentional murder, third degree murder, and

second degree manslaughter. The case is set for trial April 1, 2019. In addition to all motions

previously filed by the State of Minnesota, the State now makes these additional pre-trial motions.

Memoranda in support of the motions will be separately filed except where noted.

- 1. Amended Motion Regarding Witness Sequestration. No supporting memorandum accompanies this motion.
- 2. Motion to admit evidence pursuant to Minn. R. Evid. 404(b), three of the defendant's prior acts, in its case in chief, namely:
  - a. The defendant unjustifiably pointed his gun at a motorist during a traffic stop on May 18, 2017.
  - b. The defendant avoided responding to calls for service on April 8, 2016.
  - c. The defendant reassured a 911 caller he would look for a burglary suspect, but did not, on March 5, 2016.
- 3. Motion to admit evidence in the State's case from the defendant's pre-employment psychological evaluation conducted by the Minneapolis Police Department.
- 4. Motion to exclude or limit testimony from defense witness Emanuel Kapelsohn.

- 5. Motion regarding admissibility of defendant's out-of-court statements.
- 6. Motion to admit evidence of defendant's prior act (events from July 15, 2017) as intrinsic evidence.
