- This order sets mandatory time limitations. Any extensions or other changes of these will be
  made only for good cause shown by written motion supported by affidavit. Neither a conflict
  with other court appearances nor agreement of the parties is in itself good cause for extension.
- 2. The following schedule is hereby **ORDERED:** 
  - A. The first trial will commence on **March 8, 2021, at 9:00 a.m.** Location of trial will be determined at a later date. Order of trial of individual defendants and whether some or all defendants are to be joined for trial will be decided at a later date.
  - B. All discovery and notices required by Rule 9.01 or Rule 9.02 or Rule 11.04 shall be completed on or before **August 14, 2020**. Failure to make timely disclosure will presumptively result in preclusion of any matter not disclosed. Any discovery received by a party after the discovery deadline shall be disclosed within 24 hours to the opposing party.

- C. Motions specific to this case and capable of resolution before trial, with the exception of motions *in limine*, shall be served and filed on or before **August 28, 2020**. The court will order a briefing schedule as to each particular motion shortly after each motion is filed.
- D. Any motion or request for relief, the basis for which arises after the date in paragraph C above, must be made as promptly as reasonably possibly or will be presumptively waived.
- E. A Contested Omnibus Hearing will be held on **September 11, 2020, at 9:00 a.m.**The expected length of the Contested Omnibus Hearing is one day.
- F. The parties shall meet and seek agreement on a proposed jury questionnaire and forward a draft of the proposed questionnaire to chambers by **November 1, 2020**. Parties may supplement the proposed questionnaire with individual questions upon which the parties did not agree.
- G. Motions *in limine* shall be filed by **February 8, 2021**. Motions in *limine* shall be heard the first day of trial.
- H. Witness lists shall be filed by **February 8, 2021**.
- I. Proposed jury instructions shall be served and filed on or before February 8, 2021.
   Proposed jury instructions should be sent to chambers as a Microsoft Word document.
- J. Exhibit lists shall be filed by **March 1, 2021**. All exhibits shall be pre-marked as "Exhibit ####" and listed on the exhibit list with a short, general description (e.g. photo of scene). The State shall use exhibit numbers 1-1000. Defendant Chauvin shall use exhibit numbers 1001-2000. Defendant Thao shall use exhibit numbers 2001-3000. Defendant Lane shall use exhibit numbers 3001-4000. Defendant Kueng shall use exhibit numbers 4001-5000.

3. All documents shall be filed and served using the court's e-file and serve system. All defendants shall sign up for e-service in all four of the above-captioned cases. The defendants shall file only in those cases in which they are a party, but shall serve all other defendants, even if defendants are not joined for trial.
