PRELIMINARY STATEMENT

Rather, this is an administrative proceeding controlled by the Minnesota Administrative Procedure Act.")).

This list may be shortened, as Relators will continue to attempt to reach stipulations with the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency ("MPCA") and Poly Met Mining, Inc. ("PolyMet") (collectively, "Respondents"), and Relators intend to make certain motions *in limine* that may obviate the need for certain witnesses.

Thus, while Relators do not intend to necessarily call every witness on this list, Relators reserve their right to call each individual listed, as well as any individuals listed by Respondents. (See Am. Order Setting Evid. Hr'g \P 5).
