SCHEDULING ORDER NO. 2

- 1. *Preliminary Issues*. The panel requests that the parties work toward a stipulation on certain preliminary issues, including but not limited to:
 - Are the current districts unconstitutionally flawed in light of the 2020 Census?
 - Which Census data should be used and as of what date?
 - What are the ideal populations for congressional, senate, and house districts?
 - What is the maximum tolerable percentage deviation from the ideal for legislative districts?

All parties should participate in working toward this stipulation. One party shall file and serve the stipulation by Friday, September 24, 2021.

For any issue that the parties do not resolve by stipulation, each party shall file and serve a concise statement of its position on those issues by Friday, September 24, 2021. This statement shall be no more than five pages long.

2. Redistricting Principles. The panel also requests that the parties work toward

a stipulation on proposed redistricting principles. All parties should participate in working

toward this stipulation. One party shall file and serve the stipulation by Tuesday, October

12, 2021.

To the extent the parties do not agree as to redistricting principles, each party shall

file and serve proposed redistricting principles by Tuesday, October 12, 2021. The parties'

responses shall be due Wednesday, October 20, 2021.

Parties may request oral argument on the issue of redistricting principles in writing

by October 20, 2021. If requested, the panel will hear oral argument on Wednesday,

November 3, 2021, at the Minnesota Judicial Center. The panel will set the details of the

oral argument at a later date.
