- Marriage license issued by any Minnesota county
- Photo ID for each applicant
- Two witnesses with photo ID (or ask the judges' staff if witnesses may be provided at additional charge)
- Judges perform ceremonies Monday through Friday by appointment at <u>courthouse locations</u>. Check with individual judges for other arrangements, including weekend or evening ceremonies or locations other than a courthouse. Request specific instructions from judges' staff regarding building access outside of regular business hours. Marriage ceremony fees vary based on date, time, and location; contact the judges' staff for this information.
