JUVENILE VS ADULT COURT JURISDICTION (Rev 2/2020)

An Adult Court Traffic Offender is a juvenile who is charged with an adult court traffic offense and was at least 16 at the time of the offense. *See* Minn. Stat. § 260B.225, subds. 1-4.

"Adult court traffic offense" means:

a petty misdemeanor violation of a state or local *traffic* law, ordinance, or regulation, or a petty misdemeanor violation of a federal, state, or local water *traffic* law, not a part of the same behavioral incident of a misdemeanor being handled in juvenile court; or
a violation of section <u>169A.20</u> or any other misdemeanor- or gross misdemeanor-level *traffic* violation committed as part of the same behavioral incident as a violation of section <u>169A.20</u>.

Traffic offenses are offenses "under chapter 168, 169, 169A, or 171, 86B (Water Safety, Watercraft, and Watercraft Titling), and any other Minnesota Statute, Code of Federal Regulations, administrative rule, or ordinance offense where the Certify to DPS flag has been set in MNCIS as required by law." *See* <u>Statewide Payables List</u> Traffic/Criminal.
