## List of Non-Public Case Types

**Publication Date:** December 18, 2020

**Intended Use Date:** January 1, 2021

General Rule of Practice 11.03, as amended effective January 1, 2021, generally requires all people who file non-public documents into public court cases to identify and designate the documents as non-public. Under General Rule of Practice 11.03(d), these requirements do not apply to non-public case types. To assist filers, General Rule of Practice 11.03(d) directs the State Court Administrator to maintain and publish a list of non-public case types in which filers are not required to identify and designate non-public documents. Accordingly, the State Court Administrator has published the following list of non-public case types:

Adoption	MINN. R. ADOPT. P. 7
Assisted Reproductive Technology	<p>MINN. R. ADOPT. P. 7; MINN. GEN. R. PRAC. 11.03; Minnesota Judicial Council Policy 506 (Uniform Court Practices); State Court Administrator Policy 506(q) (Court Administration Processes); Court Administration Process 330.20 (Assisted Reproductive Technology Case Processing)</p> <p><i>Note: The Assisted Reproductive Technology case type is used only when the requested relief is to establish parentage of a child conceived as a result of assisted reproductive technology. Because these proceedings often require a non-public adoption proceeding, the entire Assisted Reproductive Technology case file is presumptively classified as non-public.</i></p>
Delinquency Extradition (Juvenile Criminal) Juvenile Petty Offense Juvenile Traffic	<p>MINN. R. JUV. DELIN. P. 30.02, subd. 3(B).</p> <p><i>Note: The Delinquency Felony (Age 16 and Older) case type is public. MINN. R. JUV. DELIN. P. 30.01. Filers are required to identify and designate non-public documents filed into Delinquency Felony (Age 16 and Older) cases, which are commonly referred to as "D16" cases.</i></p>

Parental Notification of Abortion	MINN. R. PUB. ACC. 4, subd. 1(v)(1); Minn. Stat. § 144.343, subd. 6(3) <sup>1</sup>
Paternity ( <i>for cases filed before January 1, 2021</i> )	<p>MINN. R. PUB. ACC. 4, subd. 1(n)  <i>Paternity cases which were filed before January 1, 2021, and for which no subsequent filings have occurred after July 1, 2015. If there is a post-July 1, 2015 subsequent filing, such as a custody modification motion (but not a direct appeal of a final adjudication), after there has been a final adjudication of paternity in the case, filers are required to identify and designate non-public filings in these cases because the register of actions has become public under MINN. R. PUB. ACC. 4, subd. 1(n).</i></p> <p><i>Paternity case records in cases that are filed on or after January 1, 2021, are presumptively public, and filers are required to identify and designate all non-public filings.</i></p>
