I, CLAIRE ELISABETH ELLIOTT (a/k/a CLAIRES
ELISABETH NELSON), come forward to submit to
THE COURT my marriage certificate from Honolulu
County, Hawaii Dated July 3RD, 1985; ^{EXHIBIT "A"} my divorce
judgement from Los Angeles County, California
Dated June 11, 1992; ^{EXHIBIT "B"} my Decree changing name
from Los Angeles, California ^{EXHIBIT "C"} Dated January 12, 2007;
and my final Decree changing the name of an adult
from Richmond County, Georgia ^{EXHIBIT "D"} Dated February 20, 2015.

ON June 27, 2016 - THE VERY SAME DAY of THE
VERY FIRST public hearing in THE PRINCE case - I
re-filed for Divorce in Richmond County, Georgia
(2016 RCDO0829) after discovering that my
ex-HUSBAND had used a different name on

our marriage certificate than what I had used in both my previous divorces from him. I did this prior to making my very first public appearance in the Prince case on July 4th, 2016.

When I heard nothing back from the court, I eventually re-filed for divorce yet another time in Columbia County, Georgia on January 9, 2017, this time only using the names that appear on our marriage certificate. (2017D0016)

The divorce in Columbia County immediately went forward and I was even able to obtain return receipts back from two (2) of the four (4) U.S. addresses that I had for my ex-husband even though he lives in an unknown location in Japan with his new wife and 10-year-old son. The notice of publication that I sent him was also successfully delivered to a third address of his, even though I never received back any return receipt.

Two days prior to what was supposed to be our ⁽²⁾ final divorce hearing (on April 28, 2017),

Judge Craig - The very same judge who ordered my name to be legally changed back to my legal maiden name: Claire Elisabeth Elliott, on February 20, 2015 - discovered that I already had a divorce case open in the county of my residence with the very same defendant and ordered the case to be transferred to Judge Jolly in Richmond County.

During our final divorce hearing which finally took place on June 14, 2017 in Richmond County, Judge Jolly repeatedly stated for the record that: I have been legally divorced since June 11, 1992; my legal name is Claire Elisabeth Elliott because a marriage certificate is NOT a legal name change; and I am legally married to Dean Wayne Boyd, ^{EXHIBIT "E"} even if my legal name remains Claire Elisabeth Elliott because I have never changed my name at the Department of Motor Vehicles or the Social Security office.

Judge Jolly informed me that she will be dismissing my case, but her office is currently backlogged and will not be able to update the system until the end of this week.

I am in the process of ordering the court record transcript from the court reporter, but the typist is currently on vacation, so the transcript will not be ready until at least July 20, 2017. I will be speaking with the court reporter tomorrow (well, later today) and will emphasize that we have a firm, solid deadline and absolutely need this transcript by no later than July 20, 2017.

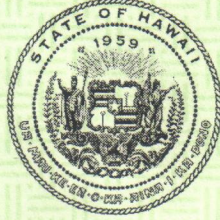
