Dear Judge Eide:

We write on behalf of Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A., in its role as personal representative (“Personal Representative”) of the Estate of Prince Rogers Nelson (“Estate”) in response to the letter filed by counsel for Sharon, John, and Norrine Nelson (“SNJ”) on November 1, 2017.

Specifically, we agree with the Court’s suggestion during the October 31 telephone conference that the parties work with a facilitator/mediator to attempt to resolve the perceived communication problems that have led to SNJ’s unhappiness with the Personal Representative. We met with counsel for SNJ yesterday in an attempt to reach an agreement (subject to the consent of counsel for the other Heirs) on the role of the facilitator, as well as resolve the open issues around the terms of Mr. McMillan’s non-disclosure agreement.

In the event that the parties are able to reach an agreement this week on the role and identity of the facilitator, we will submit a stipulation to the Court. If not, we will request that the Court appoint the facilitator as well as define his or her role.
