Explanation to Statement of Claim



Dear Central Minnesota Legal Services Board of Directors:

September 8, 2016

In 1998 I sought and retained your legal services involving my Marital Separation, Divorce and Child Custody. My Attorney was Jean Lastine. During the time of 1998- January 2001, when my Divorce was finalized, an audit of a lifelong Trust in my name that did not come to Term until my Fiftieth Birthday, was being addressed because a person, that claimed to be a Half Brother of mine and I had always thought it possible for him to be so, signed as main trustee through Carver County Court Proceedings in 1992. With Central Minnesota's investigation, it was revealed that my Half Brother, or rather his financial department had misappropriated funds, and through court proceedings, a DNA Hair Sample test was conducted proving that he was indeed a Half Sibling to me, and Half Uncle to my three children, therefore eliminating the notion that he had perhaps been untruthful of our biological relation to gain control of my Trust. He is Prince Rogers Nelson. I have applied a claim to his estate as such.

I am requesting the files from your office associated with these court proceedings for my records. I am requesting that the DNA Test results taken at that time to be turned over to Carver County Court Administration, in Luo of the Prince Rogers Nelson Estate, as evidence.

In 2001, I signed an Affidavit in your Minneapolis office, in Jean Lastine's office, assigning her as the Main Trustee overseeing all associated financial things associated with the Trust and incoming Interest and Royalties. I am unsure if these filings remained on going case in Carver County, or if it now resides in Hennepin County where I resided in 2001 and where your Law Firm is located.

Jean Lastine also retained at that time a box, or boxes, of Childhood Memorabilia of my Biological Mother and Father, Pictures, my Original Birth Certificate, Name Changes, Boxes of Contracts. Many identity items. **I wish to regain my personal items.**

I am formally requesting for an account of the Status of the Trust that Jean Lastine was in 2001 assigned as Main Trustee, along with an explanation of its Status, and what course of action I need take to reunite with me with my Trust, that I think became payable in September of 2011, five years ago, when I turned Fifty Years Old.

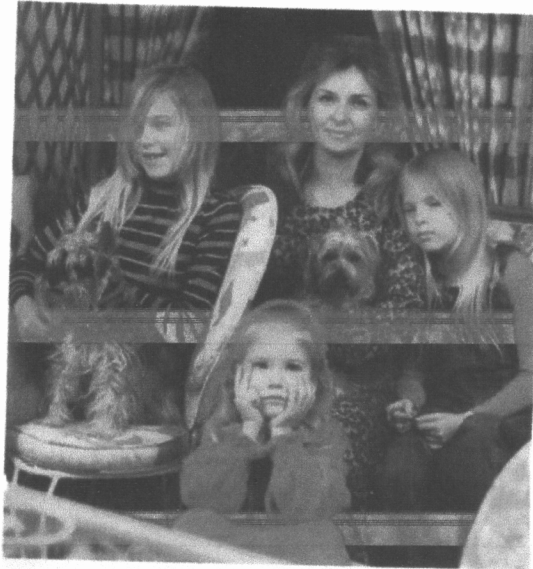
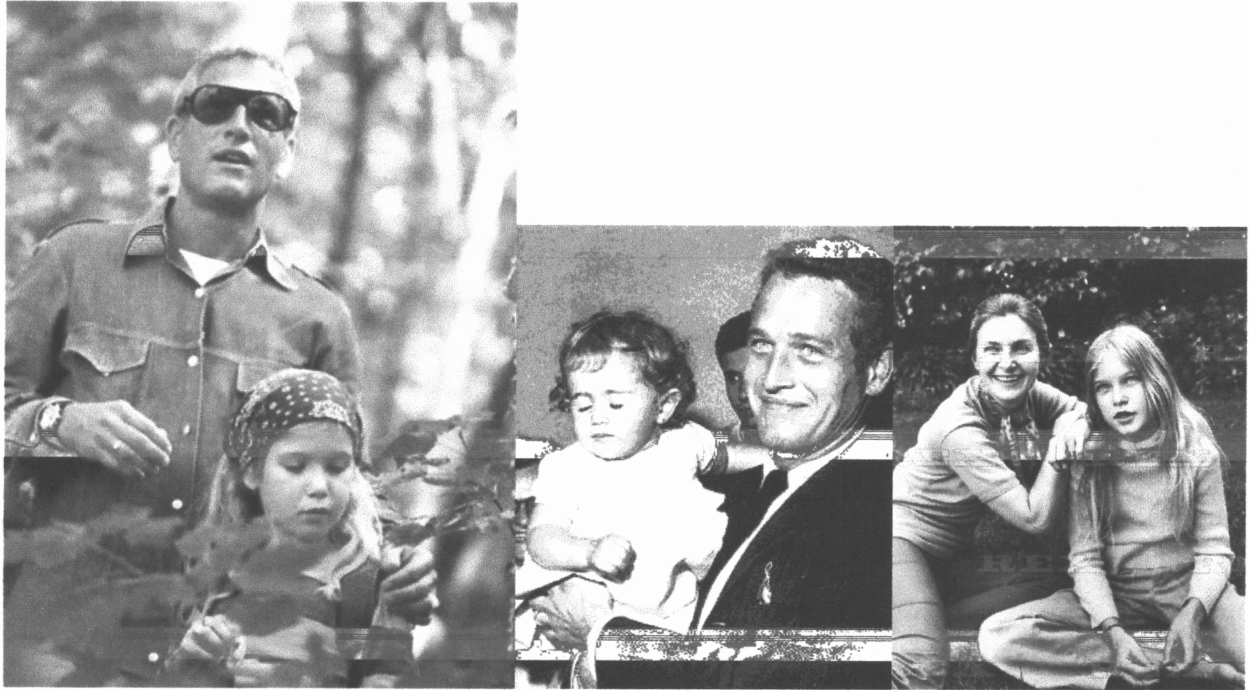
