**WHEREAS** if the actual party does not appear in court to testify about the facts of their case, the court may not be able to render an appropriate decision


**WHEREAS**, MN Rule of Court, General Rule of Practice, Conciliation Court Rule 512(c) require the parties to appear unless otherwise authorized by the court. Now therefore,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

Hennepin County Conciliation Court staff shall refuse for filing any claim filed by a Power of Attorney on behalf of an INDIVIDUAL. Claims filed on behalf of an individual under a DURABLE Power of Attorney may be accepted with the approval of the civil presiding judge.
