Parents Forever Online Parent Education Course	<p>The University of Minnesota Extension Service's "<a href="http://www.parentsforever.org">Parents Forever</a>" <a href="http://www.parentsforever.org">Online Course for Parents</a> is the only online course that currently complies with the amended Parent Education Minimum Standards. The online Parents Forever course is 8 hours in length, covers all content required in the Minimum Standards, includes video and interactive technology, is accessible 24-hours a day, and can be completed in chunks rather than in one sitting for use by parents with busy schedules. It requires parents to pass quizzes at the end of each segment and provides a printable certificate upon successful completion of the course. The course costs \$89 per person, unless the parent is determined by the court to be IFP. A sliding fee scale is also offered for parents who do not have court-ordered IFP status, but who cannot afford to pay the full fee. Parents should contact the Parents Forever program (<a href="mailto:parentsforever@umn.edu">parentsforever@umn.edu</a>) to process course registrations with IFP or sliding fee payments.
