STANDING ORDER

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute § 260B.171 and Rule 30 of the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure designate the juvenile court as the custodian of juvenile court records; and

WHEREAS, Rule 30.01 of the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure defines juvenile records, in part, as all records maintained by juvenile probation officers, county home schools, and county detention agencies; and

WHEREAS, Rule 30.02 of the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure states that the court may order juvenile court records to be made available for inspection, copying, disclosure or release, subject to such conditions as the court may direct, to any person for whom such record is needed to assist or to supervise the child in fulfilling a court order or to any person having a legitimate interest in the child or in the operation of the court; and


WHEREAS, employees of the Link who work at the Juvenile Supervision Center have a legitimate interest in accessing the Hennepin County Juvenile Probation MAIn database in order to accurately assess the appropriate services necessary for juveniles referred to the Juvenile Supervision Center; and

WHEREAS, Hennepin County Juvenile Probation has a legitimate interest in accessing the Link's Juvenile Supervision Center information in order to monitor a juvenile's compliance with court-ordered services;

THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE THE STANDING ORDER OF THE COURT:

1. Employees of the Link who work at the Juvenile Supervision Center shall have Read Only access to the Hennepin County Juvenile Probation MAIn database in order to accurately assess the appropriateness of services for juveniles referred to the Juvenile Supervision Center.
2. Hennepin County Juvenile Probation shall have access to information provided by the Link staff at the Juvenile Supervision Center in order to monitor a juvenile's compliance with court-ordered services.
3. The information contained in the aforementioned databases is confidential and shall only be used for the purposes mentioned above. It shall not be utilized or disclosed to anyone else under any other circumstances without a court order.
