REVOKED LICENSE - send the following forms to the DPS Driver & Vehicle Services:

- Participation Agreement signed & dated
- Certificate of Insurance
- Special Review Awareness form signed & notarized if you have had more than one DWI
- Reduced Fee application signed & notarized

CANCELLED LICENSE - send the following forms to the DPS Driver & Vehicle Services:

- Participation Agreement signed & dated
- Application for Ignition Interlock Limited
 License signed & dated
- Last Use Statement signed & notarized or signed by a DPS representative
- Completed chemical use assessment that includes your date of birth or driver's license number faxed by provider to DVS 651-797-1738
- Completed Certificate of Insurance
- Reduced Fee Application signed & notarized

Fifth Judicial District Eligibility Criteria for Ignition Interlock Assistance

Resident of Blue Earth, Brown,
 Cottonwood, Faribault, Jackson, Lincoln,
 Lyon, Martin, Murray, Nicollet, Nobles,
 Pipestone, Redwood, Rock or Watonwan
 County

OR

have a criminal case that originated in the Fifth Judicial District

- On probation or supervised release
- Have more than one DWI on record or a BAC at or above 0.16 on a first-time DWI
- Completed Fifth Judicial District
 Application for Ignition Interlock
 Assistance and met income guidelines
- Ignition Interlock is not already installed
- Applied for financial assistance from the state ignition interlock program

Fifth Judicial District Application Form

- You may pick up an application from your probation agent or online at: www.mncourts.gov/district/5/?page= 4833
- You may apply for assistance from the judicial district any time BEFORE the device is installed. You will receive a letter indicating your level of eligibility and the next steps to follow.

Installation Assistance

Everyone eligible for the Fifth Judicial District's Ignition Interlock Assistance Program will have the <u>full</u> <u>cost</u> of ignition interlock installation paid as long as the program has sufficient funds.

Monthly Fee Assistance

You may also be eligible to receive help to pay the monthly cost to lease the ignition interlock device for up to one year. This could be a savings of \$20 to \$70 per month, depending on your household income level.

REVOKED or CANCELLED LICENSE: Steps to install Ignition Interlock

- Make sure you're eligible to apply to install ignition interlock
 - a. Age 18 or older
 - Own or have access to a vehicle (not a moped or motorcycle)
 - c. Vehicle is insured
 - d. Not subject to Vanessa's Law because of a DWI before age 18
 - e. You have no other withdrawals on your license
- Pass DWI knowledge test, pay reinstatement fee, apply for a new Class D license and purchase new plates if yours were impounded.
- Complete and send to Driver & Vehicle Services (DVS) its forms, which differ depending if your license is cancelled or revoked (see back).

- Notify the Ignition Interlock Coordinator once you are approved to install ignition interlock at 507-238-3226 so that payment arrangements are in place BEFORE installation.
- Install Ignition Interlock, but DO NOT
 DRIVE until notified you are able to do so
 by DVS. Have someone drive you to your
 installation appointment.

Valid License and COURT-ORDERED: Steps to install ignition interlock
