 Early neutral evaluation (ENE) is a short term, confidential evaluative process designed to facilitate prompt dispute resolution in Family Court matters. 			
2. It is understood that all ENE sessions will occur between and and the parties			
present with counsel for each party.			
3. <u>Confidentiality</u> . The parties will not: a. Subpoena the evaluators or any records containing the notes or impressions of the evaluators;			
b. Evidence produced during the ENE process that is not otherwise discoverable remains confidential. The parties and counsel are prohibited from attempts to obtain through discovery or use as evidence any records deemed to be confidential under the ENE process.			
c. The parties will not subpoen the evaluators, any members of the evaluator's staff, or any records or documents of the evaluator in any legal proceedings of any kind. If so called or subpoenaed, the evaluator may refuse to testify or produce the requested documents.			

Fees. The parties agree to pay for services of the evaluators at flat rate of \$600.00 per session with each party responsible for one half of the fee. Additionally, there is a \$25.00 travel fee per party per session if the neutral must travel more than 25 miles from their location.
