ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE GENERAL RULES OF PRACTICE

The Supreme Court Advisory Committee for the General Rules of Practice filed a report on July 31, 2019, recommending amendments to the General Rules of Practice for the District Courts to address the submission of confidential records and data in court documents, primarily in Rules 11 and 14 of those rules. The Advisory Committee also recommends amendments to the rules to clarify the procedures authorized to be implemented by court administration in the event of a failure to comply with the restrictions on submitting confidential records or data. A copy of the Advisory Committee's report, with the recommended amendments to the rules, is available on the Minnesota Appellate Courts Case Management System (P-MACS), which can be accessed on the judicial branch website. The court will consider the proposed amendments after reviewing any public comments on the Advisory Committee's recommendations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Any person or organization wishing to provide written comments in support of or in opposition to the recommendations of the Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee for the General Rules of Practice, and the amendments proposed in the report filed on July 31, 2019, shall file those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts,

using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to do so. See Minn.

R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a)(1). All comments shall be filed so as to be received no later than

December 17, 2019.

2. A hearing will be held before this court to consider the recommendations and

proposed amendments to the General Rules of Practice for the District Courts. The hearing

will take place in the Supreme Court Courtroom, State Capitol, Saint Paul, Minnesota, on

January 29, 2020, at 10 a.m. Any person or organization desiring to make a presentation

at the hearing in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to the General

Rules of Practice for the District Courts shall file a request to so appear along with one

copy of the material to be presented with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts, using the

appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to do so. See Minn. R. Civ.

App. P. 125.01(a)(1). All requests and accompanying materials shall be filed so as to be

received no later than December 17, 2019.
