ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE

ORDER

The Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Rules of Civil Procedure has recommended amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure to clarify the operation of some rules, and establish procedures for rejection of documents that contain restricted identifiers or other non-public information. The committee's report with the proposed amendments to the Rules of Civil Procedure is available on the public access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, under case number: ADM04-8001 - Rules Report - Proposed Amendments to the Rules of Civil Procedure (filed June 4, 2019). The court will consider the proposed amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure after reviewing any comments on the committee's recommendations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Any person or organization wishing to provide comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments shall file one copy of those comments electronically, using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, so as to be received no later than August 27, 2019.

2. A hearing will be held to consider the proposed amendments to the Rules of Civil Procedure. The hearing will take place in the Supreme Court Courtroom, State Capitol, Saint Paul, Minnesota, on September 25, 2019, at 10 a.m. Any person or organization wishing to make an oral presentation at the hearing in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments shall file, electronically, a request to appear at the hearing, along with one copy of the material to be presented, so as to be received no later than August 27, 2019.
