**ORDER ESTABLISHING COMMENT PERIOD ON
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE
RULES FOR NO-FAULT INSURANCE ARBITRATION**

The Minnesota Supreme Court No-Fault Standing Committee on the Rules for No-Fault Insurance Arbitration has recommended amendments to Rules 12 and 40 of the Rules for No-Fault Insurance Arbitration to promote efficiency in the arbitration process, specifically with respect to motion processes, and amendments to Rule 10. The committee's reports with the proposed amendments to the Rules for No-Fault Insurance Arbitration are available on the public access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, under case number: *ADM09-8011-Final Report – Recommendations of Minnesota Supreme Court No-Fault Standing Committee*, both filed June 6, 2019. The court will consider the proposed amendments to the Rules for No-Fault Insurance Arbitration after reviewing any comments on the committee's recommendations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Any person or organization wishing to provide comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments shall file one copy of those comments electronically, using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, so as to be received no later than August 27, 2019.

2. A hearing will be held to consider the proposed amendments to the Rules for No-Fault Insurance Arbitration. The hearing will take place in the Supreme Court Courtroom, State Capitol, Saint Paul, Minnesota, on September 25, 2019, at 10 a.m. Any person or organization wishing to make an oral presentation at the hearing in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments shall file, electronically, a request to appear at the hearing, along with one copy of the material to be presented, so as to be received no later than August 27, 2019.
