ORDER REGARDING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA RULES OF JUVENILE PROTECTION PROCEDURE AND THE MINNESOTA RULES OF ADOPTION PROCEDURE

The Advisory Committee for the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure and the Rules of Adoption Procedure has recommended amendments to those rules to make necessary changes to the rules in light of changes and amendments to the Indian Child Welfare Act and related laws and regulations; and additional amendments that will facilitate the use of the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure by judges and practitioners. The committee's report, with recommendations and proposed rule amendments, was filed on November 13, 2018, and can be accessed on the appellate courts' case management system, which is available at www.mncourts.gov. The court will consider the committee's report and the recommended amendments to the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure and the Rules of Adoption Procedure after providing a period for public comments.

Based on all the files, records, and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization that wants to provide written comments in support of or opposition to the proposed amendments to the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure or the proposed amendments to the Rules of Adoption Procedure shall file one copy of those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts, using the appellate courts' electronic filing system if required to do so, *see* Minn. R. Civ.

App. P. 125.01(a)(1). All comments shall be filed so as to be received by the Clerk on or

before February 19, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a hearing will be held before this court to consider

the proposed amendments to the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure and the Rules of

Adoption Procedure. The hearing will be held on March 27, 2019, in the Supreme Court

Courtroom, State Capitol, Saint Paul, Minnesota, at 10:00 a.m. Any person or organization

that wants to make an oral presentation at the hearing, in support of or in opposition to the

proposed amendments to the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure or the Rules of

Adoption Procedure, must file a request with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts to so appear,

using the appellate courts' electronic filing system if required to do so, see Minn. R. Civ.

App. P. 125.01(a)(1). The request must filed so as to be received by the Clerk on or before

February 19, 2019.
