In a Harassment case, the court must keep your address and telephone number confidential, if you ask. Under Minn. R. Pub. Access 4, subd. 1(a)(2), if your address or phone is confidential the information will not be accessible to the public and may be disclosed only to court personnel or law enforcement for purposes of service of process, conducting an investigation, or enforcing an order. Your request only affects the case you are currently starting. There may be other cases in the court records involving you, where your address is public.
