**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RESCINDING
TWO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS**

WHEREAS, Minnesota Governor Tim Walz declared a peacetime state of emergency in a series of Executive Orders due to the worldwide spread of COVID-19, also referred to as the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the most recent Executive Order issued by the Governor ended the “stay at home” phase of the emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court also issued a series of Emergency Administrative Orders limiting the operation of Minnesota courts due to the peacetime state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2020, the Chief Justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court filed Administrative Order ADM20-8001, which superseded all prior emergency administrative orders, reissued the substance of the May 1, 2020 emergency administrative order, placed the Judicial Branch in the “transitional phase”, and adopted the emergency measures without an expiration date; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 484.69, subd. 3, the Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District used his general administrative authority over the courts in the Second Judicial District to issue a series of administrative orders; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned has been asked to rescind any Administrative Orders limiting visitation at DOC-licensed juvenile facilities and no objection to the request has been received:


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The undersigned has determined that the following Administrative Orders are rescinded effective June 1, 2020:
 - a. Administrative Order Restricting Visitation at the Ramsey County Juvenile Detention Center (filed March 25, 2020 and twice extended).
 - b. Administrative Order Restricting Visitation at Brittany’s Place Shelter (filed March 26, 2020 and twice extended).
2. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to limit, modify, or rescind any other Administrative

Order issued by the undersigned as a result of the COVID-19 emergency.
