**Camera Views:** Court staff can adjust camera views in each courtroom, if needed.

**Exhibit Display:** There are two options to display audio and visual exhibits.

- Option 1: HDMI Cable – located at counsel table to allow counsel to connect their devices to courtroom audio and visual.
  - Includes adapters that are compatible with most devices
    - To ensure device will display video and/or play sound in the courtroom, it is highly recommended that all open programs and applications on the device be closed before connecting to the adapter in the courtroom.
    - Attorneys can report to the courthouse early to test all devices before court begins. Contact Court Administration in advance to ensure the courtroom will be opened for testing.
- Option 2: Zoom – Court staff enables screen-sharing to allow participants to share screens.
  - If sharing video: share through Zoom video player (Share Screen button>Advanced Tab>Video) or, click Optimize for Video Clip and Share Sound

**Joining Zoom Meeting:** Join the Zoom meeting from your laptop.

- If you are in the courtroom, mute the audio on your device to avoid feedback.
