The Anoka County Law Day Open House is offering Criminal (including Juvenile) Expungement and Eviction Expungement Clinics

What: Criminal (including Juvenile) Expungement and Eviction Expungement Clinics

When: Friday, April 26, 2019, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

There will be a video presentation on the expungement process when you enter the clinic. After the presentations, volunteer attorneys will be available to help clients fill out the expungement forms and IFP (fee waiver) applications. Expungement and IFP forms will be available at no charge. If the expungement form is complete, court dates will be given and copies, envelopes and stamps for mailing will be given at no charge. Expungement forms will be mailed and the Affidavit of Mailing will be completed.
