Description of Incident:

D. was in possession of a replica firearm at a movie theater. D. pointed the gun at another person and threatened him. D. then went out of the theater and waived the gun around. D. was causing a disruption at the theater. When police arrived, D. ran. He was also uncooperative and belligerent towards officers.

Police Action Taken:

Police investigated and D. was released to his mother.

### PRINCIPAL OR CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER

The Woodbury Police Department has probable cause to believe that the above student of your school has committed a delinquent act that is to be reported to you under Minnesota State Statute 260B.171 Subd. 5e. The law enforcement officer will check all violations that apply.

- The victim of the offense is a student or staff member of the school, and that notice to the school is reasonably necessary for the protection of the victim.
- Murder: 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> degree
- Criminal Vehicular Homicide
- Robbery: Simple or Aggravated
- False Imprisonment
- Tampering with a Witness
- Burglary: 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> degree
- Harassment and/or Stalking
- Controlled Substance Crimes: 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> degree
- Controlled Substance: Importing
- Manslaughter: 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> degree
- Assault: 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> degree, domestic assaults
- Kidnapping
- Criminal Sexual Conduct: 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> degree
- Arson: 1<sup>st</sup> degree
- Terroristic Threats
- An Act Involving the Possession/Use of a Dangerous Weapon

A law enforcement agency is not required to notify the school under this statute if the agency determines that notice would jeopardize an ongoing investigation.

### CHEMICAL ABUSE PREASSESSMENT TEAM

The Woodbury Police Department has probable cause to believe that the above student of your school has committed a delinquent act that is to be reported to you under Minnesota State Statute 121A.28. The law enforcement officer will check all that apply.
