ORDER

In an order filed on September 29, 2020, we approved a pilot project to evaluate the use of legal paraprofessionals in certain case types. *Order Implementing Legal Paraprofessional Pilot Project*, No. ADM19-8002 (Minn. filed Sept. 29, 2020). The pilot project will be administered by a standing committee under the rules promulgated in that order, and the standing committee will work with State Court Administration to monitor, evaluate, and report on the project.
