**SACHS PLAINTIFFS’ MOTION TO ADOPT
PROPOSED CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING PLAN**

Pursuant to the scheduling order issued by the Special Redistricting Panel (the “Panel”) on October 26, 2021, Plaintiffs Frank Sachs, Dagny Heimisdottir, Michael Arulfo, Tanwi Prigge, Jennifer Guertin, Garrison O’Keith McMurtrey, Mara Lee Glubka, Jeffrey Strand, Danielle Main, and Wayne Grimmer (the “Sachs Plaintiffs”) hereby submit this motion to adopt their proposed congressional redistricting plan.

Concurrently with this motion, the Sachs Plaintiffs have filed the following materials:

- Memorandum in Support of Motion to Adopt Proposed Congressional Redistricting Plan
- Proposed Congressional Redistricting Plan (in Excel format)
- Congressional Maps (including the entire state and the 11-county metropolitan area)

- Population Summary Report

Additionally, pursuant to the Panel's plan submission requirements, the Sachs Plaintiffs have submitted one paper original and eight paper copies of their congressional map to the Panel. The Sachs Plaintiffs will also provide the Legislature and the Governor with a block-equivalency file for their proposed congressional plan.

¹ The Sachs Plaintiffs note that their Minority Voting-Age Population Report automatically includes an inaccurate set of definitions at the bottom of the page. Instead of these definitions, the reported statistics actually reflect the November 3, 2021, release of census data from the Minnesota Legislature.
