ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON PETITION FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF THE MINNESOTA BOARD OF CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION

On March 7, 2025, the Minnesota State Board of Continuing Legal Education filed a petition recommending amendments to the Rules of the Minnesota Board of Continuing Legal Education. The proposed amendments would broaden continuing legal education (CLE) course approvals by revising current limitations on in-house programming. The petition and proposed amendments are available on the public-access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, under case number ADM09-8008 – Petition of the Minnesota State Board of Continuing Legal Education for Amendment of the Rules of the Minnesota State Board Continuing Legal Education (Minn. filed Mar. 7, 2025).

The court will consider the petition and proposed amendments to the Rules of the Minnesota Board of Continuing Legal Education after providing a period for public comment and reviewing any comments on the proposed amendments.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization that wants to provide comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to the Rules of the Minnesota Board of Continuing Legal must file those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts consistent with the filing requirements of Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a). All comments must be filed so as to be received by the Clerk's office no later than June 23, 2025.
