ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE

The Minnesota State Bar Association (MSBA) has filed a petition to amend the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure, specifically Rule 30.02(f) of those rules. The MSBA states that the proposed amendments to Rule 30.02 would bring the rule into conformity with the corresponding federal rule, Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(6), and would improve the practice of law in Minnesota. The MSBA's petition with the proposed amendments to the Rules of Civil Procedure is available on the public access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, under case number ADM04-8001 – *Petition of the Minnesota State Bar Association to Amend the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure* (filed June 17, 2021). The court will consider the proposed amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure after reviewing any comments filed regarding the proposed amendments.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization wishing to provide comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure shall file one copy of those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts, using the appellate courts' electronic filing system if required to do so. *See* Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a)(1). All comments shall be filed so as to be received by the Clerk on or before December 6, 2021.
