

STATE OF MINNESOTA IN SUPREME COURT ADM10-8003

ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA RULES OF JUVENILE DELINQUENCY PROCEDURE

On July 28, 2022, we directed the Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure to consider whether the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure should be amended to create a procedural mechanism for a post-adjudication or post-certification evidentiary proceeding to develop a record for a claim of ineffective assistance of counsel, or any other appropriate claim. The committee filed its report and recommendations on October 9, 2023. *See* Report and Proposed Amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure, No. ADM10-8003 (filed Oct. 9, 2023). We opened a public comment period and received two comments from the Minnesota County Attorneys Association and the Office of the Minnesota Appellate Public Defender.

After further consideration, including review of the written comments filed, we have decided that a public hearing will assist the court's consideration of and decision on the committee's proposed amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Juvenile Delinquency Procedure.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a hearing will be held before this court. The hearing will take place in the Supreme Court Courtroom, State Capitol, Saint Paul,

Minnesota, on October 22, 2024, immediately following the conclusion of the first public

hearing scheduled at 9:00 a.m. on that date. Any person or organization who wishes to

make a presentation at the hearing shall file a request to appear, which shall include a copy

of any material to be presented at the public hearing if different than or supplemental to the

previously submitted public comments. This must be filed with the Clerk of the Appellate

Courts, using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to do so. See

Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a). All requests to appear must be filed so as to be received

by the Clerk's office no later than Wednesday, October 2, 2024.
