ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE SPECIAL RULES FOR THE PILOT EXPEDITED CIVIL LITIGATION TRACK

On January 11, 2023, the contributors to the Expedited Litigation Track Pilot Project filed a report recommending amendments to the Special Rules for the Pilot Expedited Civil Litigation Track. The report with the proposed amendments is available on the public-access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, under case number ADM10-8051 – *Expedited Litigation Track Pilot Project Final Report* (filed Jan. 11, 2023).

The court will consider the proposed amendments to the Special Rules for the Pilot Expedited Civil Litigation Track after providing a period for public comment and reviewing any comments on the proposed amendments. The court will also consider making the pilot project permanent across the State.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization wishing to provide written comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to the Special Rules for the Pilot Expedited Civil Litigation Track, or to making the pilot project permanent across the State, shall file those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to do so. *See*

Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a). All comments shall be filed so as to be received by the Clerk's office no later than Tuesday, April 18, 2023.
