ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO MINNESOTA RULES OF GENERAL PRACTICE, MINNESOTA RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE, AND MINNESOTA RULES OF CIVIL APPELLATE PROCEDURE

On March 21, 2022, we directed the Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the General Rules of Practice for the District Courts, the Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure, and the Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure to review the petition filed by the Minnesota State Bar Association (MSBA) proposing amendments to establish presumptive personal leave for attorneys. In re Proposed Amendments to Minnesota Rules of General Practice, Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure, and Minnesota Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure, ADM09-8009, ADM04-8001, ADM09-8006 (Minn. filed Mar. 21, 2022). Each committee has filed their reports, which are available on the public access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, ADM09-8009 – Recommendations of Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on General Rules of Practice (filed June 23, 2023), ADM04-8001 – Recommendations of Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on Rules of Civil Procedure (filed June 23, 2023), and ADM09-8006 – Recommendations of

Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure

(June 28, 2023).

The court will consider the recommendations after providing a period for public

comment and public hearing.

to be received by the Clerk's office no later than October 10, 2023.

at 10 a.m. Any person or organization who wishes to make a presentation at the hearing

shall file a request to appear along with one copy of the material to be presented with the

Clerk of the Appellate Courts, using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if

required to do so. See Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a). All requests and accompanying

materials shall be filed so as to be received by the Clerk's office no later than October 10,

2023.
