**ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF
PUBLIC ACCESS TO RECORDS OF THE JUDICIAL BRANCH**

The Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Rules of Public Access to Records of the Judicial Branch has recommended amendments to Rule 4 of the Rules of Public Access to address legislation passed in 2020 regarding court records in guardianship and conservatorship matters. *See* Act of May 16, 2020, ch. 86, art. 1, 2020 Minn. Laws 294. The committee's report with the recommended amendments to Rule 4 is available on the Minnesota Appellate Courts Case Management System (P-MACS), which can be accessed on the judicial branch website. The court will consider the proposed amendments after considering any public comments on the committee's recommendations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization wishing to provide written comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to the Rules of Public Access to Records of the Judicial Branch shall file those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts, using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to do so. *See* Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a)(1). All comments shall be filed so as to be received no later than February 19, 2021.
