## STATE OF MINNESOTA IN SUPREME COURT ADM10-8005

## ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF THE MINNESOTA CLIENT SECURITY BOARD

On April 21, 2023, the Client Security Board filed a petition recommending amendments to the Rules of the Minnesota Client Security Board. The petition asserts that the rules have not been materially amended since their original adoption and proposes both housekeeping and substantive amendments. The petition and proposed amendments are available on the public-access site for the Minnesota Appellate Courts, under case number ADM10-8005 – In Re Petition to Amend the Rules of the Minnesota Client Security Board (filed Apr. 21, 2023).

The court will consider the proposed amendments to the Rules of the Minnesota Client Security Board after providing a period for public comment and reviewing any comments on the proposed amendments.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization wishing to provide written comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to the Rules of the Minnesota Client Security Board shall file those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to

do so. *See* Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a). All comments shall be filed so as to be received by the Clerk's office no later than Monday, July 17, 2023.
