### **Right to Counsel**

A parent or Indian custodian has the right to an attorney appointed by the Court without charge if the Court determines they are financially eligible.

## Right to be Granted, upon Request, Additional Days to Prepare for the Third Party Custody Proceedings

A parent, Indian custodian, or tribe has the right to, upon request, be granted up to 20 additional days to prepare for the proceedings.

#### Right to Ask to Transfer Case to Tribal Court

A parent, Indian custodian, or tribe has the right to file a written request to transfer the proceeding to the tribal court.

### Potential Legal Consequences on the Future Parental and Custodial Rights of Parent or Custodian

THE PURPOSE OF THIS CASE is to determine permanent custody for the child named above, pursuant to the Petitioner's petition for third party custody. Permanent custody may be accomplished by the parents consenting before a judicial officer of a court of competent jurisdiction, or by the petitioner proving, along with testimony of a qualified expert witness, that the continued custody of the child by the parents or Indian custodian is likely to result in serious emotional or physical damage to the child for one or more of the reasons listed on the attached petition.

If the tribe fails to respond to this Notice, the Court may be asked to find that the ICWA does not apply to this proceeding, and the matter may proceed without tribal involvement.

All who receive this Notice must keep confidential the information contained in this Notice, and the notice should not be handled by anyone not needing the information to exercise rights under ICWA.
