INSTRUCTIONS NOTICE OF INTENT TO PROCEED TO JUDGMENT

1.	Fill out	and sign	the <i>Notice</i>	of Intent to	Proceed to	Judgment.

- 2. Make three copies.
- **3.** Serve your spouse with a copy of the *Notice of Intent to Proceed to Judgment* at his or her last known address by first class U.S. mail.
 - Papers cannot be served on a legal holiday.
 - The form you prepared can be served by any of the following:
 - o The sheriff;
 - o Another adult; or
 - o You.
- **4.** The person who mailed the *Notice* fills out the *Affidavit of Service by Mail* and signs it under penalty of perjury. By signing the Affidavit under penalty of perjury, the server is stating that the information in the Affidavit is true to the best of his / her knowledge. Perjury is the crime of intentionally lying or misrepresenting the truth, punishable by jail or other sanctions.
- 5. Keep one copy of the *Notice* and one copy of the *Affidavit of Service* for your records.
- 6. File the original *Notice* and the *Affidavit of Service by Mail* with the Court.
