Party with Attorney

If a party has an attorney, regardless of court fee waiver status, the party shall be charged ½ the normal hourly rate charged by that party's attorney. If the party is represented by multiple attorneys at a firm, the party shall be charged ½ of the attorneys' average normal hourly rate.

<u>Unrepresented Party, Represented by Legal Aid/Pro Bono Attorney, or Court Fees Waived</u>

If a party is unrepresented or is represented by legal aid or pro bono attorney (no attorney fees), or the judge waived the party's court fees, the following rates apply:

	Flat rate SENE fee for each party for initial 4-hour SENE session	Flat rate FENE fee for each party for initial 3-hour FENE session	Hourly rate for each party after initial session for SENE or FENE
Unrepresented	\$400	\$350	\$100
Court Fees Waived Legal Aid, Pro Bono	\$200	\$150	\$50

If a party does not have an attorney at the ICMC, but hires an attorney before the ENE session, that party's fees shall be recalculated based upon the party with attorney rate.

Preparation Work

The providers will not charge for any work they do before the ENE session without prior agreement with the parties or their attorneys.

Flat Rate Fee for Initial ENE Session

The fee for the initial ENE session is a flat rate. This is the minimum fee due even if the session ends early.
