

Sherburne Moderated Settlement Conference (MSC) Fee Scale

(Current as of April 2021)

If a party is represented by counsel, that party will be charged one-half the hourly rate charged by that party's counsel. Counsel shall provide the MSC Neutral with their accurate hourly rate within five days of the entry of the MSC Order. In the event that the party is represented by more than one attorney at a firm, the attorneys shall provide the MSC Neutral with all of the attorney rates charged to the client, and the client shall be charged one-half of the average hourly rate.

If a party is not represented by counsel, the party's fee is based on their individual gross income pursuant to the following sliding fee scale:

- i. IFP granted by Court - \$50.00 flat fee
- ii. 0-\$25,000 annual income - \$25.00 per hour
- iii. \$25,001-\$50,000 annual income - \$50.00 per hour
- iv. \$50,001-\$100,000 annual income - \$100.00 per hour
- v. \$100,001 or more annual income - \$200.00 per hour.
