Dear Judge Eide:

We write in response to the notice of filing an attorney's lien by WWB. The lien is claimed for services rendered to Alfred Jackson prior to his death in connection with the Prince Estate.

As the court is aware, the Jackson Estate sold the entirety of its interest in the Prince Estate to my client, Primary Wave, well before this lien was asserted. The submissions by WWB also do not advise the court that they filed a claim for attorney fees in the Jackson Estate which was rejected by the Missouri court.

It's not clear how or against whom WWB intends to assert its purported lien, since the Jackson Estate no longer has any interest in the Prince Estate, and there currently is no property interest in the Prince Estate to which the lien may attach.

WWB has requested that the court set a date for a hearing to determine and establish the existence of the lien and ordering the entry of judgment in favor of WWB and against Jackson's interest in these proceedings. We respectfully submit that before the court sets a hearing concerning the existence and amount of the lien, it should require WWB to indicate its position with regard to what interest may be attached by the lien, and who are the proper responding parties. Resolution of these threshold issues will undoubtedly make further proceedings more streamlined.
