The above-entitled matter came before the Honorable Kathryn Quaintance during a Sentencing Hearing on June 7, 2019, in courtroom 1059 of the Hennepin County Government Center, 300 South Sixth Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota.

Amy Sweasy, Esq., and Patrick Lofton, Esq., appeared on behalf of the State of Minnesota.

Thomas Plunkett, Esq., and Peter Wold, Esq., appeared with and on behalf of Defendant Mohamed Noor (“Noor”).

During the aforementioned proceeding, the Court pronounced convictions on Count II: Murder in the Third Degree, and Count III: Manslaughter in the Second Degree. In regards to Count II, the Court then sentenced Defendant to 150 months in the custody of the Commissioner of Corrections with 41 days credit as time served. The Court did not sentence Defendant on the Count III conviction, noting it as a lesser included offense.

It has come to the Court's attention that the pronouncement was incorrect; Count III as a lesser included offense should not have been pronounced as a conviction, rather it shall remain as an adjudicated guilty verdict. Pursuant to Minnesota Rules of Criminal Procedure 27.03 subdivision 9,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The conviction on Count II and sentence shall stand as pronounced,
2. The conviction on Count III shall be vacated, and shall remain as an adjudicated guilty verdict.
