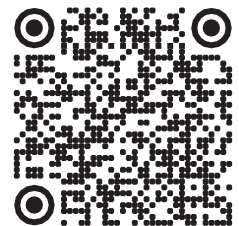

GAPP SERVICES <i>Not Accessible</i>	Mostly Monday-Friday 8 a.m.–5 p.m.	Twin Cities metro area. Ride must originate in Dakota County.	Free	952-953-9299	Need to schedule ride one to two weeks in advance. Priority is for medical, dental and social service appointments.
